
Event Graph Comparison

*Filter students by country













Prof. Lee's research interests include Chinese history, Chinese society and economy, comparative demography, sociology of populations, as well as historical sociology, genealogy and health.

Online Course


DESCRIPTION

This course demonstrates how a new scholarship of discovery is redefining what is singular about modern China and modern Chinese history, and offers perspectives derived from Chinese experience over the last three centuries. Part One focuses on the 'the Fittest' as seen through the framework of comparative population behavior - mortality, marriage, and reproduction – and their interaction with economic conditions and human values. Part Two focuses on 'the Chosen' as seen through the lens of comparative opportunity for education. Part Three and Part Four focus on 'the Rich' and 'the Powerful' and address two related questions 'Who gets what?' and 'Who rises to the top?'.

本課闡釋了源自大數據的學術發現如何重新定義近現代中國及其歷史的獨特性。較之此前基於西方經驗及透過西方視角闡釋的人類歷史和社會理論,本課程呈現了跨越三百年歷史的另類中國經驗。利用數據分析的方法,沿著嶄新學術發現的脈絡,我們以四個互相獨立的部分展開具體的案例研究。第一基於比較人口學框架,關注"生存者";第二通過教育公平比較的視角關注"勝出者";第三及第四部分則對"為富者"與"有權者"相關問題進行解讀。

Prof. Zweig's research interests cover three areas: the world migration of human talent, in particular Chinese who studied abroad and then returned to China; international political economy, including China's search for energy and resources, and their impact on Sino-American relations; and Hong Kong-Mainland relations, including the role of Hong Kong and its people in China's modernization. He is the author of four books, editor of five books as well as another three special issues of academic journals. His book, Internationalizing China (2002), was published in Chinese in 2011 by the Renmin University Press.

崔大偉教授的學術研究集中在三個領域展開:全球人才遷移與流動,尤其是海外歸國的中國留學生;國際政治經濟,包括中國能源需求及對中美關系影響;香港與內地關系,即香港及港人對內地現代化的影響。崔教授出版有個人專著四部,編輯學術論著五部,及三種學術期刊的特刊。他的專著《國際化的中國》(2002)2011年由中國人民大學出版社出版。

Online Course

DESCRIPTION

One of the most significant changes in the world in the past 40 years is the opening of China to the outside world and its engagement with that world. In the first 20 years of the opening, external forces influenced China's economy and capital flows, regional (im)balances, internal migration, the interests and power of the bureaucracy, as well as the political authority of local leaders in the coastal areas. More recently, the world is feeling the effects of a rising China which seeks resources, energy and talent from all around the globe and uses its financial wealth to strengthen its influence in the world. This course tracks the opening of China up from 1978 until it joined the WTO (2001), focusing on how the world affected China's internal development. We then look at various aspects of China's "going out strategy"—its search for energy, talent, the Belt and Road Initiative, as well as its relations with the United States and the states within the Asia-Pacific region.

過去四十年全球最具有深遠意義的變化是中國對外開放及參與國際事務。對外開放的最初20年中,外部力量對中國的經濟與資本流動、區域平衡、內部遷移、官僚機構的利益與權力,及其沿海地區地方領導人的政治權威有著全方位的影響。近年來,世界已經感受到中國崛起帶來的影響。中國正在從全球尋求資源,能源和人才,並利用其金融財富來增強其在世界的影響力。本課沿著中國自1978年改革開放的軌跡,重點關注世界如何影響中國的內部發展,並探討中國"走出去戰略"的各個方面,包括探索能源和國才,"一帶一路"倡議以及與美國和亞太地區各州的關係。





China's Economic Transformation, Parts 1 and 2

Professor Park's research interests include economic development, transition, labor, education, applied microeconomics, and Chinese economy.

朴之水教授的研究范疇囊括經濟發展、經濟過渡、勞動力、應用微觀經濟學及中國經濟。朴教授聯合中國社會科學院、清華大學學者對地處華南和華中的廣東和湖北兩大制造業大省進行了兩次大規模調研,該項目涉及1208加企業和11366名員工。其研究報告表明,正在經歷發展方式轉型關鍵節點的中國,通過加大研發投入、優化企業管理、提高全要素生產率等手段,並依託政府創新補貼,實業產業升級優化,來應對勞動力成本帶來的挑戰。

Online Course

DESCRIPTION

This course shows the Economic Reform and Growth in China and Human Dimensions of Economic Development in China. In Part One, we will describe the origin and consequences of China's key economic reforms since 1978 and to what extent China has integrated itself into the global economy. In Part Two, we will focus on China's population policies and China's massive internal migration, and Analyze the supply, demand, and regulatory factors influencing employment outcomes of skilled and unskilled workers.

China and Africa

Barry Sautman is a political scientist (PhD Columbia University) and lawyer (JD UCLA, LLM NYU). His recent research is China-Africa links, including political economy, labor rights, migration between China and Africa and interactions between Chinese and Africans, representations and perceptions of China and Chinese in Africa, and the supposed strategic rivalry between the US and China in Africa. One of his areas of research has been ethnic politics in China and comparative perspective, including ethnic policies, the political economic and legal aspects of the Tibet and Xinjiang issues.

作為政治學學者及律師,沙伯力教授的近年來專注中非關系,包括政治經濟、勞工權利、中國與非洲的移民、中非之間的互動、非洲對中國的看法以及美國與中國在非洲的戰略對抗。沙教授多年來致力於基於實證調研的中非關係研究,有利於對中非關係的更全面的認知。沙教授的研究也包括從比較視角研究中國的民族問題、政策、西藏與新疆的政治經濟和法律問題等,他研究全球政治家和媒體對這些問題的疑惑和對中國異議。

Online Course

DESCRIPTION

This course examines many of the most debated topics in the discourse of China and Africa links, based on fieldwork and empirical studies. Part I analyzes China-Africa ties in the context of Africa's colonial background and the current global neoliberal order. It focuses on Chinese investment in Africa, especially mining and agriculture. Part II describes key social issues related to the Chinese presence in Africa, such as ethnicity and enterprise localization. It also analyzes whether Chinese and Western practices in Africa differ.

本課程基於田野調查和實證研究,探討中非關係中最受爭議的話題。本課第一部分分析了非洲殖民背景和當前全球新自由主義秩序背景下的中非關係,專注於討論中國在非洲尤其是採礦和農業的投資。第二部分講述了中國人在非洲的關鍵社會問題,例如種族關係和企業本地化。課程還分析了中國與西方在非洲所作所為是否存在差異。

A 2004 Guggenheim Fellow and 2016-2019 Changjiang Scholar, Professor Campbell's research is largely in comparative sociology. His research focuses on the relationships between kinship, inequality, and demographic behavior. He has published extensively on family, population, and stratification in eighteenth and nineteenth century northeast China, for example, one book he co-authored with Professor James Lee is Fate and Fortune in Rural China. Prof. Campbell also published on a wide variety of topics, such as economic, family and social influences on marriage, ethnic identity as reflected in naming behavior, and inter-generational social mobility, among others.

康文林教授是2004年古根海姆學者及2016-2019年長江學者。康教授主要從事比較社會學研究。他的研究關注宗族、不平等及人口行為間的關聯。他出版的專著涵蓋對中國東北18-19世紀家庭、人口及分層的研究,他的專著之一是與李中清教授合著的Fate and Fortune in Rural China。他發表的其他研究專題涉及經濟、家庭和社會對婚姻的影響、姓名行為反映的民族認同、以及代際社會流動性等。康教授和李中清等學者等在頂尖學術期刊合作發表了有關經濟、家庭、社會等因素對人口表徵影響的多篇論著,涉及中國歷史上的結婚、生育、節育、移民、死亡,以及家族網路對社會流動的影響等。

DESCRIPTION

This course describes differences in the goals, basic paradigms, and research methods of the major social science disciplines. Students are expected to identify the key parts of a research proposal, learn the major sources of data for use in social science research and the most common approaches for inferring a causal relationship from quantitative data.

Online Course

DESCRIPTION

This course explores in general terms how engineering as well as scientific knowledge and practice are influenced by dynamic interactions between science, technology, innovation, and society. The course will introduce the innovation systems approach, laying the groundwork for mastering the remaining two parts of the course by introducing broad concepts and ideas to provide students with a platform on which to think about the science/technology-society relationship and related policy issues with a focus on China. Part Two will examine the impact of the Industrial Revolution in the West on scientific and technological progress in China.

本課程概括性介紹了科學知識與實踐如何受到科學、技術、創新及社會相互作用的影響。課程將介紹創新體系研究方法,通過引入廣義概念和觀點,為學生提供一個以中國為焦點去思考科學/技術與社會之間的關係以及相關政策問題的平台。這將為掌握本系列其餘兩部分課程奠定基礎。第二部分課程將研究西方工業革命對於中國科技進步的影響。

Prof. Sheng was awarded the Genius Award, The MacArthur Foundation Fellowship in 2001. He is respected as one of the foremost composers of our time and his music has been programmed by almost every important orchestra in the world. He also performed many important orchestra and opera works worldwide, including Red Silk Dance, Tibetan Swing, Flute Moon, The Silver River, The Dream of Red Chamber etc. Sheng also maintains an active career as a conductor and concert pianist. As a frequent artistic director and advisor he has appeared at many of the world's most prestigious music centers.
