## New RPG Housing Policy

### General Policy

All full-time full fee paying students are eligible for student accommodation while in-time RPg will have priority.

All 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> year RPg students \*, including local and non-local student, who apply for housing will be assigned a bed space by Student Housing Office (SHO). Remaining bed spaces will be allocated to Schools (pro-rated by in-time RPg numbers). Each school will have their own policy to distribute the quota of bed spaces.

*\* 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> year of student's RPg career at HKUST (e.g. MPhil/PhD student who completes 2 years MPhil will be considered as a 3rd year student for housing when starting PhD)*

### SHSS Policy

- Priority will be given to students in final year of in-time study (For PhD students, this is generally the 3<sup>rd</sup> year of PhD studies for those who have previously done an MPhil and the 4<sup>th</sup> year for those who haven't.)
- Non final-year in-time applicants will all have the same (lower) priority.
- Out-time students are given the lowest priority.
